As we are about to close the second quarter of the year, the economy is showing slow but steady signs of recovery. Covid-19 cases are on the decline, as well as the hospitalization rate. It is reassuring to note that some form of normalcy will resume soon if we continue to observe all protocols such as frequent sanitizing, handwashing, social distancing and getting vaccinated.

We are constantly devising new strategies to ensure that our products remain attractive and that our members always have access to several loan options. In April, we increased the Easi-Access loan maximum to \$2.750M and increased the repayment period to 55 months to ensure that each member wishing to access this facility can do so with manageable monthly payments.

You asked, and we not only listened but delivered on our promise to extend the debt consolidation loan to external institutions. On June 1, 2021, the Super Consolidation loan was increased to a maximum of \$5M and the repayment period extended to 120 months. Members accessing this facility can now consolidate external loans at banks and other Credit Unions up to \$1M and \$4M in house.

We have introduced new enhancements to make it easier to interact with our team members. You can now chat directly with our representatives via WhatsApp when you visit our website. We are also excited to announce that non-members can now start their account opening process online to facilitate less time spent at our locations.

ATM & DEBIT CARD **SAFETY TIPS**

Whether you are brand new to using a ATM/Debit card, or you have been using one for years, It is always good to give yourself a refresher course on how to use your card safely and keep it protected.

- PIN SAFETY: never write your PIN on a piece of paper and store it in your wallet, never write it on the back of your card or share it with anyone. Memorize it and keep it to yourself.
- **USING YOUR PIN**: always remember to shield the keypad from others when entering your PIN at the supermarket, gas stations, doctor's office etc.
- YOUR SORROUNDINGS: Always be aware of your surroundings when using the ATM, make sure you use one in a busy area that is well lit. Be wary of people loitering around at the ATM. If your surroundings do not feel comfortable, find another location to conduct your banking.
- ATM WITHDRAWALS: When making a cash withdrawal at an ATM, always put your cash away before exiting the ATM.
- YOUR INSTINCTS: If something doesn't look or feel right about an ATM area trust your instincts and leave. It is always better to be safe than sorry.
