

### **CEO MESSAGE**

Can you believe that we are approaching the end of 2021? As we close in on the last month of a tumultuous year, I implore you to reflect on the year, and celebrate the positive things that you were able to accomplish despite the odds.

This time of the year is used to reflect and to acknowledge the work, challenges, and achievements throughout the Credit Union. 2021 is a unique year with new and unprecedented challenges facing not only the

Credit Union but the entire Jamaican financial landscape. While facing new challenges, we continue to deliver exceptional products and services to our members to meet and exceed their expectations.

In April, our loan products were reviewed and updated to ensure that every member benefit from our loan offerings. The Easi Access loan was increased to \$2.291M and the repayment period extended to 55 months. The Easi Access loan amount was also increased in September to \$2.5M and the repayment period extended to 60 months. Effective December 1, the Easi Access loan was increased to \$2.750 with 66 months to repay, just in time for the Christmas holidays!

The repayment periods were extended for the Supreme and the Demand loan for 48 and 36 months respectively and a refinancing component added to the PSE/NHT Micro loan to ensure that members benefiting from this loan can refinance after 12 monthly payments.

In June the Super Consolidation loan was increased to \$5M, and members taking up the offer had the option of consolidating their loans at banks and other Credit Unions up to \$1M. Our members were ecstatic and less than a month after we increased the portion used to consolidate external loans to \$2M. With so much uncertainty remaining for 2021, I want to remind you that your Credit Union stands as a trusted source of support and assure you that we will continue to operate in a safe and sound manner despite the current economic challenges. We will continue to seek opportunities to make your banking experience as simple and seamless as possible. You deserve nothing less from us.

This Christmas will be especially poignant, as we connect with our families and friends in a different way. I wish you a very happy, healthy, and safe holiday season as we look forward to a positive New Year.

# FINANCIAL TIPS SAFEGUARD YOUR MONEY DURING THE FESTIVE SEASON


The holiday season is just around the corner. Here are some safety tips to keep your private information safe from cyber criminals:

- 1. Make sure your computer anti-virus and spyware security programs are working and up-to-date.
- 2. Enroll in Credit and Debit Card Alerts in Online Banking to receive text messages that will help you monitor for suspicious account activity.
- 3. Only shop at secure websites as indicated by a padlock icon in the address bar of your web browser and/or a URL address with the 'https' pre-fix.
- 4. Use strong passwords when setting up an online account with a service provider.
- 5. Save records of your online transactions, including a description of items purchased, transaction prices, electronic receipts, terms of sale, and copies of any email exchanges with a seller.
- 6. Regularly review your account statements and transaction history online to help identify unauthorized charges.


